AN ORDINANCE to ascertain and determine the probable cost of constructing a lateral sever, which the Council of the City of Albany has determined by mesolution No. 13, adopted on the 11th day of May, 1927, beginning at the north end of the lateral sewer now in place, which is at the southeast porner of lot No. 2 in block 1 in Albany Heights' Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon, and running thence northerly through the center of block 1 and block 2, in said Addition, to the northeast corner of lot 7 in block 2, in said addition, a distance of 770 feet; to ascertain, assess, determine and declare the proportionate share of said probable cost of gaid improvement that is assessed upon the lots or parts thereof, or parcels or tracts of land adjacent to gaid improvement; to direct the decorder of said City to enter a statement of said assessment in the docket.of City Liens, as provided by the charter of said City. ter of said City.

WHERMAS, on the 11th day of May, 1927, the Mouncil of the City of Albany, Oregon, by hesolution No. 12 required Charles H. Leonard, Ingineer, to prepare plans and specifications for the construction of a lateral sever beginning at the north end of the lateral sever now in place, which is at the scutheast corner of lot 2 in block 1 in Albany Heights' Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon, thence running northerly through the center of block 1 and block 2, in said addition, to the northeast corner of lot 7 in block 2 in said addition, a distance of 770 feet, and for the estimate of the work to be done and the probable cost thereof, and requiring such plans, specifications and estimates of the probable cost to be filed in the office of the Recorder of said City on the 11th day of May, 1927, and

WHAMGAS, said Engineer, pursuant to said Resolution No. 12 made plans, specifications and estimates, as directed by said Resolution for the construction of said lateral sewer, and filed the same with the Recorder, as aforesaid, on the 11th day of May, 1927, and

WHAMGAS, the Council on the 11th day of May, 1927, by Resolution No. 13, duly adopted by the Council, determined and resolved that it deemed it expedient, and that

said Council proposed to construct said lateral sewer, baginning at the north end of the lateral sewer now in place, which is at the southeast corner of lot 2 in block 1 in Albany Heights' Addition to Albany, Oregon, and running thence northerly through the center of block 1 and block 2, in said addition, to the northeast corner of lot 7 in block 2, in said addition, a distance of 770 feet, and

WHREAS, the Recorder in pursuance of said Assolution No. 13, gave due notice of said improvement in the manner provided by the charter of said lity, and on the 13th day of July, 1927, pursuant to said notice, U.G. Hayne submitted his old to the Council for the making of said improvement for the sum of 4773.60, which said bid was received andacospted by the Council in and by ordinance MO. 1250, passed by the Council on the 13th day of July, 1927, and approved by the Mayor on the 13th

day of July, 1927.

THEREFORE, THE PROPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBAMY, OREGON, DO ORDAIL AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That an 8" vitrified terra cotta sever shall be constructed, beginning at the north end of the lateral sewer now in place, which is at the southeast corner of lot 2 in block 1 in Albany Heights' Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon, and running thence northerly through the center of block 1 and block 2, in said addition, to the northerst corner of lot 7 in block 2, in said addition, a distance of 770 feet, in accordance with Resolution No. 13, and the plans and specifications for said improvement filled by said Charles H. Heonard, Engineer, in the office of the Recorder of said City on the 11th day of May, 1927

Section 2. That the probable cost of making said improvement, in the manner hereinabove determined by the Council of said Jity, and by said hesolution No. 13, is hereby declared to be the sum of \$935.60, and the probable cost of said improvement, to be paid by the owners of the property adjacent thereto and particularly ben-efited thereby, is the sum of 3440.60.

Section 3. That the proportionate share of said probable cost of said improvement assessed upon each lot or part thereof, or parcel or troot of land adjacent thereto, as assessed and dtermined by the Council, is hereby determined and ascertained to be the sum set and placed immediately after the separate description of each of said lots, or parts thereof, or parcels or tracts of land, as follows, to-wit:
