## ORDINANCE NO. 1859

All ORDINANCE authorizing and directing the dayor and Recorder of the City of Almbany, Oregon, on behalf of the common council of said City, to make, execute and deliver to St. Johns' Rodge A.F. and A.M., of Albany, Oregon, a corporation, a quitclaim deed of conveyance of certain lands belonging to said City, and providing that said property be used for cametery purposes.

WHERTAS, by Resolution No. 15. duly and regularly adopted by the flouncil of the City of Albany, Gregon, on the 8th day of June, 1927, the Mayor of said City was authorized to advertise and sell the following described real property, to-wit:

Reginning at an iron rod on the westerly boundary line of the Pacific Highway and on the north line of and south.88 legrees 45 minutes west 7.67 chains distant from the northesst corner of the D.T.C. of Anderson Cox and wife, being Medification No. 696 and Claim No. 49 in Township 11 South angle 3 lest of the Willamette weridien, Oregon, thence south 88 degrees and 45 minutes west along the north line of said claim 15.45 chains to the sentern houndary line of the mint of row of the Southern Oregon, thence south 80 degrees and 45 minutes west along the north line of said claim 15.45 chains to the eastern boundary line of the right of way of the Southern Pacific Reilway Company, thence southerly along the eastern boundary line of said right of way 1.30 chains to the northwest corner of a 4.17 acre tract of land that the First Rebrew Church Congregation of Albany sold to St. Johns' Lodge No. 17 a.F. and A.M. on the 19th day of Movember, 1924, by deed recorded in volume 128, page 598 of Deed of Accords of Linn County, Oregon, thence south 50 degrees west 3.68 chains to the northwestern boundary line of the Pacific Hijlway; thence north 55 degrees cast 12.30 chains to the place of beginning, containing 6.30 acres, more or less, all lyin, in Linn County, Oregon.

And, UNRIGHAS, pursuant to raid Resolution No. 15 the Mayor did advertise and sell said real property in the manner provided by law and by said Resolution No. 15, and on the 13th day of August, 1927, made and filed his written report of said sele, showing the sale thereof to have been duly and regularly conducted, and said premises to have been duly and regularly sold to St. Johns Lodge No. 17 A.F. and A.M. of Allagy, Oregon, said report of sale being on file in the office of the accorder of the City of Albany, Oregon, where the same is now a matter of public record; and

VHEREAS, it now appears to the Council that the sale of said property was duly and regularly advertised and said property sold in the manner provided by law and that no better price could be obtained from a resale thereof;

THERNFORE, THE PROPER OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO GRDAIN AS FOLLIES: "

Section 1. That the Mayor and Accorder of the City of Albany, Oragon, be and are hereby authorized and directed to make, execute and deliver, on behalf of the Common Council of said City, to St. Johns Lodge A.F. and A.M., of Albany, Oragon, a corporation, a quitclaim deed of conveyance to the following described real be and they

property, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron rod on the westerly boundary line of the Rolfic Hillway and on the north line of and south 88 degrees 45 minutes west 7.67 chains distant form on the north line of and south 88 degrees 48 minutes west 7.67 chains distant form the northeast corner of the D.L.C. of Anderson Cox and wife, being lotification No. 696 and Claim No. 49 in Township 11 South Range 3 West of the Willamette Leridian, Oregon, thence south 93 degrees 45 minutes west along the north line of said claim 15.45 chains to the eastern boundary line of the right of way of the Southern Facific kailway Company, thence southerly along the eastern boundary line of said right of way 1.30 chains to the northwest corner of a 4.17 acre tract of land that the First Hebrew Church Congregation of Albany sold to St. Johns Lodge No. 17 A.F. and A.M. on the 19th day of November, 1924, by deed recorded in Volume 188, page 595 of Deed of Appords of Linn County, Oregon, thence south 50 degrees west 8.68 chains to the northwest boundary line of the Pacific Mighway, thence north 55 degrees east 12.30 chains to the place of beginning, containing 6.30 scree, more or less, all lyin in Linn County, Oregon.

Section 2. That said deed of conveyance shall contain a restriction clause providing that said property shall at all times be used for cemetery purposes only, and that the sale of lots or parts thereof shall be made to the general public and not limited to any class or organization of individuals, provided that a portion thereof may be exchanged forotherlands to make the plat and land more desirable for cemetery purposes.
