## ORDINANCE NO. 1262

AN ORDINANCE providing for the time and manner of improving Second Street from the east line of Sherman Street to the west line of Oak Street in the City of Albany, Oregon, providing how the cost of such improvement shall be paid, the penalty or damage to the City of Albany by the person or persons making such improvement if the same shall not be completed within the time agreed upon, the giving of a good and sufficient bond for the faithful performance of the work of making such improvement, xs and providing for the giving of notice by the Recorder of said City for bids for the completion of such improvement of said portion of said Street.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF A LBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Second Street from the east line of Sherman Street to the west line of Oak Street in the City of Albany, Oregon, shall be improved in the following to-wit: manner.

First: By grading and gravelling said Street to the proper sub-grade.

Second: By surfacing the roadway of said Street 16 feet in width with gravel;
said improvement to be in accordance with the charter and ordinances of the City of Albany, Oregon, and the plans, specifications and estimates of Charles H. Leonard, Engineer, for said improvement, which said plans, specifications and estimates were filed in the office of the Recorder of said City on the 28th day of September, 1927, endorsed "Plans and Estimates of Quantities and Costs from the Improvement of Second Street from the East line of Sherman Street to the West Line of Oak Street.

in the City of Albany, Oregon."

The cost of making said improvement of said portion of Second Street shall be paid out of the funds collected and arising upon and out of the assessments hereafter to be made, ascertained and declared by the Council of the City of Albany on the lots and parts of lots adjacent to said portion of said street so to be improved, and especially and particularly benefitted thereby as provided by the charter of said City.

pecially and particularly benefitted thereby as provided by the charter of said City. Said improvement of said portion of Second Street shall be completed on or before the 1st day of December, 1927.

All bids for the making of said improvement of said Street deemed unreasonable by the Council of the City of Albany may be rejected.

Any person, firm or corporation with whom any contract may be entered into by the City of Albany for the making of said improvement, shall before the commencing the same and at the time of signing such contract, make, execute and deliver to said City a good and sufficient bond with good and sufficient surety, thereon in a sum equal to 50% of such contract price consistence for the faithful performance thereof.

Section 2. If the person, firm or corporation entering into any contract with the City of Albany to make said improvement of said Second Street shall not complete the same within the time mentioned and specified in such contract the City of Al-bany shall be deemed to suffer damages on account thereof to the amount of \$7.50 per day for each and every day the completion thereof is delayed beyond the time stated in said contract, which amount scall be paid by the contractor doing the work at the completion thereof, unless the time for such completion of such improvement be extended by the Council.

Section 3. The Recorder of the City of Albany is hereby ordered and directed to immediately give proper notice for bids for the making of said improvement of said portion of Second Street by publishing said notice ten (10) tays in the Albany Democrat-Herald, a daily newspaper published in the City of Albany, Oregon, fully describing in such notice the time and manner the doing of the work of said improvement of said Street ment of said Street.
