ORDINANCE NO. 1267

AN ORDINANCE to prohibit the parking of motor vehicles adjacent to certain portions of the United States Post Office property in the City of Albany, and providing for a penalty for violation thereof.

THE PROPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. It sha'l be unlawful for any person or persons to leave any motor vehicle standing and unattended for more than ten (ten) minutes at one time upon the streets in the City of Aloany, Oregon, adjacent to the United States Post Office property within a distance of forty-one (41) feet east-ward and a distance of forty-one (41) feet southward from the northwest core ner of said property.

Section 2. Any person or persons violating the provisions of Section 1 of this ordinance, upon conviction thereof in the mecorder's court shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$5.00 or by imprisonment in the City jail for a period of not more than two days.
