ORDINANCE NO. 1268

AN ORDINANCE to amend Section 6 of Ordinance No. 1266, entitled "An Ordinance authorizing a volunteer fire department of the City of Albany, to prescribe its duties and to regulate the same," passed by the Council December 28, 1927, and approved by the Mayor December 28, 1927.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section 6 of Ordinance No. 1266 entitled "An Ordinance authorizing the organization of a volunteer fire department of the City of Albany, to prescribe its duties and to regulate the same," passed by the Council December 28, 1927, and approved by the Mayor December 28, 1927, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows, to-wit:

Section 6. Such bills incurred in the performance of public duty and by authority of the Council of the City of Albany, shall be submitted to the Council and audited for payment in the usual course of accounts due from the City of Albany, and the Council may at its discretion, and in like manner, pay such other bills of the Volunteer Fire Department as may be regularly authorized by the department and incurred by it in carrying on its affairs, provided that such bills so audited shall not exceed, in the aggregate, the sum of \$25.00 per quarter of year.
