ORDINANCE NO. 1988

AN ORDINANCE to ascertain and determine the probable cost of certain improvements which the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, has determined to make in Resolution No. 29, adopted by said Council on the 23rd day of May, 1923, on Second Street, from the east line of Oak Street to the west line of Pine Street, in the City of Albany, Oregon, to ascertain, assess, determine and declare the proportionate share of such probable cost of such improvement of said portion of said street that is assessed upon each lot or part thereof, adjacent to said portion of Second Street to be so improved; to authorize and direct the Recorder of said City to enter a statement of such assessment in the docket of City Liens, as provided by the charter of said City:

WHEREAS, on the 23rd day of May, 1925, the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, duly adopted a resolution requiring Charles H. Leonard, engineer, to compile and file in the office of the Recorder of the said City on the 23rd day of May, 1928, plans, specifications and estimates of the probable cost of making the improvement of Second Street from the east line of Oak Street to the west line of Pine Street in the City

of Albany, Oregon, by grading and gravelling the same; and
WHERZAS, said ingeineer pursuant to said resolution made plans, specifications
and estimates as directed thereby for the improvement of said Second Street, and filed the same in the office of the decorder of said City on the 23rd day of May, 1928.

WHEREAS, the Council of said City off the 23rd day of May, 1928, by Assolution Mo.
29, duly adopted by said Council, determined and resolved that it deemed it expedient
and that the Council proposed to improve Second Street from the east line of Oak
Street to the west line of Pine Street, in the City of Albany, Oregon, in the manner
provided in said Resolution No. 29, and
WHEREAS, and by said hesolution No. 29 the Recorder of said City was duly ordered
and directed to give notice of said proposed improvement of said Second Street from
the east line of Oak Street to the west line of Pine Street, in said City, as provided

by the charter and ordinances of said City, and WHEREAS, the Recorder, in pursuance of said order and direction of the Council, did duly give notice of said proposed improvement of said Second Street in the manner pro-

wided by said Resolution, and the charter and ordinances of said City, and WHRHMAS, the said Council in and by said Resolution No. 29 ascertained and determined the total probable cost of making said improvement of said Second Street, to be psid by the owners of the real property adjacent to said portion of said street, to be improved as specified in said Resolution No. 29, to be the sum of 3311.28, and WHEREAS, by Ordinance No. 1285, after due notice of the time and in the manner provided by law, the bid of C.E. Davis for the making of said improvement of said por-

tion of Second Street was accepted and the Mayor and Aecorder of the City of Albany were thereby authorized to enter into a contract with C.R. Davis for the making of said improvement in accordance with said bid, by grading and gravelling said portion of said street, and in other respects in accordance with said Resolution No. 29.

THEREFORE THE PROPLE OF TH CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Second Street, in the City of Albany, from the east line of Oak Street to the west line of Pine Street, shall be improved as follows:

1st: By grading said portion of said street to the proper sub-grade;

2nd: By surfacing the roadway of said street 16 feet wide with gravel.

All in accordance with said Resolution No. 29, and the plans and specifications for said improvement filed by Charles H. Leonard, City Engineer, with the seconder of the City of Albany, Oregon, on the 23rd day of May, 1928.

Section 2. That the probable cost of making said improvement of said Second Street from the east line of Oak Street to the west line of Pine Street, in said City of Albany, Oregon, in the manner heretofore determined by the Council and in and by said Resolution No. 29 to be paid by the owners of the real property adjacent to said portion of Second Street, is hereby declared to be the sum of \$311.28.

Section 3. That the proportionate share of said probable cost of said improvement of said Second Street assessed upon each lot, or part thereof, adjacent to said portion of Second Street, to be improved as aforesaid, and as determined by said Council in and by said Resolution No. 29, is hereby ascertained and declared to be the sum set and placed innediately after the separate description of each of such lots,

or parts thereof, as follows: WILDER, WINNIE (I.F. Hadley life estate) .-- Lot 8 in block 16 in Hackleman's Third Addition to Albany, Oregon Assessed ELERTT, J.F.-Lot 7 in Block 16 in Tackleman's Third Addition to Albany, Assessed at \$38.91 Assessed at Oregon, STINGUIPHER, Z.T .-- Lot 6 in Block 16 in Hacklesan's Third Addition to Albany, Oregon
