**ORDINANCE No. 1294**

AN ORDINANCE to regulate the storage of crude petroleum and petroleum products within the City of Albany, Oregon, and providing a penalty for violation hereof.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Any person, firm or corporation operating or intending to construct and operate any storage station for the storage and distribution of crude petroleum, or any petroleum products, or any liquid or inflammable character whatsoever, shall make application to the Council of the City of Albany for a permit authorizing the construction and operation of such oil storage station; and no permit shall be granted for the construction, operation or maintenance of such station unless the same shall comply with all the requirements of the laws of the State of Oregon; provided further, that no such permit shall be granted unless each of such storage tanks, or a group of storage tanks, shall be inclosed with solid concrete or reinforced concrete walls, which said walls shall be capable of retaining one and one-half times the volume of such tanks inclosed, and there shall be no openings in such walls, except a drain pipe with a shut-off valve located at the lowest point thereof.

Section 2. Any person, firm or corporation who shall construct, operate or maintain any such storage station as contemplated by Section 1 hereof, without first having obtained a permit therefor, shall, upon conviction thereof before the Recorder's Court of the City of Albany, Oregon, be fined in the sum of not less than Ten Dollars (\$10.00) nor more than One Hundred Dollars (100.00).


