ORDINANCE NO. 1305

AN ORDINANCE relating to the construction of sidewalks and ourbings within certain limits in the City of Albany, Oregon.

THE PROPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBAMY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That all sidewalks that may hereafter be constructed within Linnmont Addition, Albany Heights Addition, Rose Addition, and also on the south side of Tillamook Street, adjacent to the property owned and occupied by Albany College, shall be made of cement and of the dismensions and in the manner hereinafter described;

Section 2. That all sidewalks that may bereafter be constructed within the area described in Section 1 of this ordinance shall be five (5) feet wide, and on streets less than sixty (60) feet in width such walks shall be built with the inner edge of such walks along the property line along which said walks may be constructed, and on all other streets the inner edge of such walks shall be built one foot from the property line along which said walks shall be built one foot from the property line along which said walks may be constructed.

Section 3. Along the front of the sidewalks provided for in this ordinance shell be pisced a concrete curb il feet from and parallel with the front line of the lot or block, which said curb shall be ouilt in the manner provided by the charter and ordinances of the City of Albany.

Section 4. That all sidewalks that may hereafter be constructed as provided for in this ordinance shall be placed upon the street grade as the same is now established, or that may 'rom time to time be established, and shall conform strictly to the official street grades, and shall be uniformly built in the manner provided by the charter and ordinances of the City of Albany.
