

ORDINANCE No. 1317,

AN ORDINANCE to appropriate \$600.00 of the moneys heretofore set aside for park purposes, it being a portion of the general funds of the City of Albany, Oregon, and to pay the same to D.D.Hackleman, clk. sch. dist. 5, to be paid to the Albany High School Band for services.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That there be and is hereby appropriated from the moneys heretofore set aside for park purposes, it being a portion of the general funds of the City of Albany, the sum of Six Hundred (\$600.00) Dollars for the services of the Albany High School Band, and the Recorder of the City of Albany is hereby authorized and directed to draw a warrant on the general funds of said City, payable to D.D.Hackleman, clk. sch. dist 5, for such purposes.
