CHARANCE NO

AN OMDIHANCE to regulate the mortor vehicle traffic upon the streets of the City of Albany, to provide for the establishment of safety zones upon such streets, the regulation of automobile traffic therein, and providing femalty for violation hereof;

THE PROPER OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Council of the City of Albany is hereby authorized to designate by appropriate markings upon the several streets of said City and by the erection of appropriate signs thereon areas to be known as SAFKTY ZOURS, and that such safety zones may be designated on such streets and portions of streets from time to time as to the Council may seen proper, and that when so designated the Council shall cause the same to be plainly marked with appropriate markings and signs hersinabove authorized.

Section 2. Witin all places in said Streets designated by the Council as safety zones under the provisions of this ordinance, the right of way within such safety zones shall at all times be yielded to pedestrians, and the drivers of all motor vehicles while within such safety zones shall under all discounstances operate euch vehicles under extreme caution, under absolute control thereof and without unnecessary noise.

Section 3. Any person violating the provisions of Section 2 of this ordinance, of upon conviction thereof in the Recorder's Court shall be fined in a sum not to exceed \$50.00, or by imprisonment in the city jail for a period not to exceed 25 days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.
