136R ORDINANCE NO.

AN ONDIFANCE making it unlawful to hold public meetings within any tent structure within the fire limits of the City of Albany, Oregon.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That it shall be unlawful for any person or persons to hold public meetings or any meetings where the public is invited within any tent structure within the fire limits of the City of Albany, Oregon.

Section 2. Any person violating Section 1 of this ordinance, upon conviction thereof in the Recorder's Court, shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$5.00 nor more than \$25.00, or by imprisonment in the city jail for not less than two days nor more than ten days, or by both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the Court.
