An Ordinance to appropriate the sum of \$472.50 of the general fund of the city of Albany, Oregon, for the payment of said City's one-half of the purchase price of 500 chairs for the armory auditorium and declaring an emergency.

whereas, the City of Albany and Linn County have agreed to purchase 500 chairs for public use in the armory Auditorium in said City at \$1.09 per chair, one calf the cost thereof to be some by said City and one-half the costs thereof to be borne by said County and to purchase the same from Frager furniture Company, Themerons,

THE PROPIN OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

That there be and is hereby appropriated of the general fund Section I. of the City of Albany the sum of \$472.50 in payment of the City's one-half part of the purchase price of 500 chairs for public use in the Armory Auditorium.

Section 2. That the hecorier of said City be and he is hereby authorized and directed to issue a warrant drawn on the general fund of said City, payable to Frager Furniture Company in the assunt hereinabove appropriated.

Section 3. Whereas, the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Albany require that this ordinance shall become effective immediately, therefore, an energency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall become immediately effective upon its final passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
