

ORDINANCE NO. 1406

AN ORDINANCE regulating the use of the streets and alleys of the City of Albany, Oregon, and the parking of motor vehicles and other implements thereon and providing a penalty for violation hereof.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to place any motor vehicle or parts thereof upon any street or alley of the City of Albany, and leave the same thereon unattended unless such vehicle or part thereof be capable of being propelled by its own power, and no such vehicle or part thereof shall be left upon any street or alley when not in active use, and then only for temporary purposes.

Section 2. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to use the streets or alleys of the City of Albany for the storage of motor vehicles or implements of any kind or character whereby the free and uninterrupted use of such street or alley may be impaired, provided that this section shall not be construed to be applicable to the ordinary use and parking of motor vehicles in the usual course of motor vehicle traffic.

Section 3. Any person violating any of the terms of this Ordinance upon conviction thereof in the Recorder's Court, shall be punished by a fine of not to exceed \$25.00 or by imprisonment in the City Jail for a period of not to exceed 12 days.
