

ORDINANCE NO. 1414.

AN ORDINANCE appropriating the sum of \$250.00 for the purpose of assisting in the cost of installing flood lights on Central Field in the City of Albany, Oregon, and directing the Recorder of said City to execute and deliver the General Fund Warrant of said City to Mountain States Power Company; for the amount hereby appropriated.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That there be and is hereby appropriated the sum of \$250.00 of the General Funds of the City of Albany for the purpose of assisting in defraying the cost of installing flood lights on Central Field in said City.

Section 2. The Recorder of the City of Albany is hereby authorized and directed to execute and deliver the General Fund Warrant of said City in the sum of \$250.00, payable to Mountain States Power Company for the purpose set forth in Section 1 hereof.
