

ORDINANCE NO. 1420

AN ORDINANCE to repeal Ordinance No. 1405 of the City of Albany, Oregon, entitled, "An Ordinance providing a system of Civil Service for Paid Firefighters of the City of Albany, Oregon," passed by the Council August 12, 1936, and approved by the Mayor August 15, 1936, and declaring an emergency.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 1405 of the City of Albany, Oregon, entitled "An Ordinance providing a system of Civil Service for Paid Firefighters of the City of Albany, Oregon," passed by the Council August 12, 1936, and approved by the Mayor August 15, 1936, be and the same is hereby repealed.



Whereas the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Albany, Oregon, require that this ordinance shall become immediately effective, therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall become immediately effective upon its final passage by the Council and its approval by the Mayor.
