

ORDINANCE No. 1485

AN ORDINANCE to appropriate the sum of \$1000.00 of the general funds of the City of Albany, as initial payment of the purchase price of a fire alarm system and authorizing the Recorder to draw a warrant payable to the Gamewell Company for said amount and declaring an emergency.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That there be and is hereby appropriated from the general funds of the City of Albany the sum of \$1000.00 as the initial payment on the purchase price of a fire alarm system for said City and the Recorder is hereby authorized and directed to draw and deliver a warrant in said amount payable to the Gamewell Company for the purposes hereinabove set forth.

Section 2. In as much as the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Albany is involved, therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall become immediately effective upon its final passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
