

ORDINANCE NO. 1488

AN ORDINANCE relating to and describing the seal of the City of Albany, Oregon.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The seal of the City of Albany shall be circular in form, three and three quarters inches in diameter, and shall have engraved in Roman letters around the outside circle the following words: "Seal of the City of Albany, Linn Co., Oregon." It shall have also an emblem engraved on the face of said seal, described as follows: An eagle with its wings spread, a shield upon the breast, with three arrows in its right foot. Over the head of the eagle shall be a scroll with the following words in small letters: " In God we trust."
