ORDINANCE NO. 1494

AN CRDIMADE defining and prescribing the qualifications and duties of the City Marshal.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLIOUS:

Section 1. Before entering upon the discharge of the duties of his office, the city marginal shall file with the city recorder a certificate with his oath of office as prescribed by the city charter endorsed thereon, and also a bond payable to the city of Albany in such sum as the city council may require, payable in logal tendor of the United States, with tow or more sureties who justify in like namer as bail upon arrest under the laws of the State of Oregon and to be appointed by the Layor, conditioned that he will honestly and faithfully discharge his duties as city marshal, account for and pay over to the city treasurer all money that comes into his hands by wirtue of his office, and turn over to his successor in office all books, papers, and property belonging to the City of albany that may core into his hands by virtue of his office as city marshal, and that he will faithfully and impartially perform all duties that may be required of him by the City Council.

Section 2. The city marshal shall be a conservator of the place, and shall execute all processes directed to him by the recorder of said city or by any magistrate of the State of Oregon. He shall attend regularly upon the sitting of the Recorder's Court. He may make irrests for a breach of the peace, for a violation of any city ordinance, or for the commission of crime within the city limits, the same as a pace officer may under the laws of this state. He shall collect all taxes levied by the City Council as required by ordinance, and he shall inneliately may over all money so collected by him to the city treasurer, taking the refor duplicate receipts, one of which shall be filed in the recorder's office and placed to his credit. If the marshal discovers any person doing business within the city or engaging in any occupation for which a city license is required and that person has neglected or refused to take out a license as required by the city ordinance, it shall be the duty of the city marshal to inform against and resscute such person before the city recorder and to enforce the payment of such license fee from such delinquent. In the discharge of his duties he shall exercise a vigilant control over the paace and best interests of the city. He shall perform all such other duties as may be required of him by the city cancil and shall serve all notices within the city limits which the council may direct him to serve.

Section 3. The city marshal shall have power to appoint and employ a deputy by written appointment filed with the recorder. Such deputy shall hold his office as deputy marshal subject to the orders and requirements of the city marshal in accordance with and subject to the provisions of city ordinances in force, and such deputy shall take an oath to faithfully demaen himself in office.
