

ORDINANCE NO. 1597

A Bill for an ordinance to appropriate the sum of \$1, 136.05 of the general funds of the City of Albany for the purchase of one cast iron boiler for the heating plant in the City Hall building in said City.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. WHEREAS, the City Council has heretofore accepted the bid of Arnett Appliance & Supply for the furnishing and installing of one cast iron sectional boiler for the heating plant of the City Hall of said City and that said boiler has been furnished and installed in accordance with the specifications therefor.

THEREFORE, the sum of \$1,136.05 of the general funds of the City of Albany is hereby appropriated for the payment of said boiler and the Recorder is hereby authorized and directed to execute and deliver to Arnett Appliance & Supply the general fund warrant of said City in the sum of \$1,136.05 in payment of the purchase price of the boiler hereinabove described.
