

ORDINANCE NO. 1598

BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE providing for the time and manner of vacating Fourteenth Street from the west line of Washington Street to the east line of Vine Street and the alley running in a northerly and southerly direction through Blocks c and 6, and the alley running northerly and southerly through Block 4 for a distance of 100 feet north of Fourteenth Street, all in Central Addition to said City.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, are hereby authorized and directed to proceed to vacate Fourteenth Street between the west line of Washington Street and the east line of Vine Street and the alley running northerly and southerly through Blocks C and 6 and alley running northerly and southerly through Block 4 for a distance of 100 feet north of 14th Street, all in Central Addition to the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon.

Section 2. The Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon, is hereby authorized and directed to give notice of the vacation of said portion of said street and of the alleys hereinabove described by publishing the same in the Albany Democrat-Herald, a newspaper of general circulation published in the City of Albany, Oregon, once each week for four successive weeks, which said notice shall describe the portion of said street and of said alley herein contemplated to be vacated and which said notice shall state that the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, will, on the 25th day of July, 1945, at 7:30 o'clock P.M. of said day, at the City Council Chambers of the City of Albany, Oregon, hear objections or remonstrances to the vacation of said portion of said street and alley by any person or persons interested therein and particularly by the owners of the real property effected thereby. The Recorder of said City, within five days after the first publication of said notice, shall post or cause to be posted at or near each end of said street herein proposed to be vacated and also at or near each end of said alley herein proposed to be vacated, a copy of said notice, which shall be headed "NOTICE OF STREET AND ALLEY VACATION.", and such notice shall also be posted in at least two conspicuous places within said proposed vacation of said street and of said alley. The posting and first day of publication of such notice shall not be less than twenty-eight days before the time of such hearing as hereinabove stated.

Section 3. WHEREAS, the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Albany requires that this Ordinance shall become immediately effective. THEREFORE, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall become in full force and effect immediately upon its final passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
