ORDINANCE NO. 1659

A Bill For:

An Ordinance to appropriate \$2091.00 out of the general funds of the City of albany to be used in payment for the reroofing of the City Hall Building and the Airport Hangar and authorizing payment of the same to be made to J. B. Wolford.

THE PROPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That there be and there is hereby appropriated from the general funds of the City of Albany. Cregon, the amount of \$815 charged to the City Hall Sinking Fund and the amount of \$1276.00 charged to the Airport Sinking Fund they being the prices heretofore agreed upon with J. B. Wolford for doing the work and furnishing the material as shown by the invoice therefor now on file in the office of the City Recorder of said City.

Section 2. The Facorder of the City of Albany is hereby directed to execute and deliver to J. B. Wolford the general fund warrant of the City of Albany in payment of the amount and for the purpose of the appropriation as hereinabove set forth. That the amount hereby appropriated shall be charged against the City Hall sinking fund and the Airport singking Fund of said City.

Section 3. WHEREAS, the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Albany is involved. TRIFEFOR, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall become immediately effective upon its final passage by the Gouncil and approved by the Layor.
