

ORDINANCE NO. 1725

A BILL FOR:

AN ORDINANCE to appropriate \$1135.61 out of the General Funds of the City of Albany to be used in payment for one Chevrolet Half Ton Pickup, and authorizing payment of the same to Don Densmoor Chevrolet Co.

THE PECELE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That there be and there is hereby appropriated from the general funds of the City of Albany, Oregon, and charged to the general funds, the sum of \$1135.61, it being the price heretofore agreed upon with Don Densmoor, for 1 (one) Chevrolet Half Ton Pickup as shown by the invoice therefore now on file in the office of the City Recorder of said City.

Section 2. The Recorder of the City of Albany is hereby directed to execute and deliver to the Don Densmoor Chevrolet Co. the general fund warrant of the City of Albany, in payment of the amount and for the purpose of the appropriation as hereinabove set forth. That the amount hereby appropriated shall be charged against the general fund of said City.
