A BILL FOR:

AN ORDINANCE authorizing the Mayor and Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon, to enter into a contract with Leonard & Slate Oregon Ltd. for the construction of lateral sewers as follows:

Beginning at the manhole of the railroad main sever between 2nd and 3rd 3ts., in the City of Ibany, Crecon and running thence Westerly along the center line of Blook 103, of Back's. Add. to said City a distance of 275 ft., more or less.

By laying an eight inch vitrified terra cotta sower pipe in said project in accordance with the plans and specifications of "alter ". Larsen, City Engineer, of the City of Albany, filed in the office of the Recorder of said City on the 11th day of September, 1946.

Thereas, by Resolution No. 98A adopted by the Council on the 24th day of July, 1946, it was ordered that lateral severs be constructed as follows:

Beginning at the manhole of the railroad main sever between 2nd and 3rd Sts. in the City of Albany, Oragon and running thence westerly along the center line of Block 103, of mack's. Add. to said City a distance of 275 ft., more or less.

said lateral sewers to be constructed of eight inch virtrified terra cotta sewer pipe in accordance with the plans and specifications of Walter W. Larsen, Engineer of said City, filed in the office of the Recorder of said City on the lith day of September, 1946.

Whereas, it was provided in and by Ordinance No. 1736 passed by the Council on the 24th day of September, 1946, and approved by the Mayor on the same date, that the Recorder give notice for bids for the making of such improvement in the manner provided by law; and

Thereas, due notice and advertisement for said bids have been made and given by the Recorder of the City of Albany in accordance with the provisions of said ordinance and in the manner provided by law; and

Thereas, Leonard & Slate Gregon Lts., on the 25th day of September, 1946, presented their bid to the Council of said City for the making of said improvement which said bid was made in due form and in conformity with all the conditions imposed by law and by said Ordinance, by which bid the said Leonard & Slate Gregon Ltd. proposed to furnish all material, and implements and to perform all the labor necessary to make the above described improvement for the sum of \$743.50; and

"Whereas, Leonard Slate Crecon Ltd., was the lowest bidder for said proposed work and said bid was the lowest and best bid submitted therefore.

THEREFORE THE PROPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBAHY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the bid of the said Leonard & Slate Oregon Ltd. for said improvement be and the same is hereby accepted and the Mayor and Recorder of the City of Albany are hereby authorized and directed to enter into an agreement in writing wit, the said Leonard & Slate oregon Ltd. for the making of said is provement as aforesaid on behalf of the City of Albany, bregon, and upon the torms and conditions in said ordinance, advertisement and bid hereinabove mentioned.

Said contract shall provide that the work on said sewer construction shall commence within ten days after the signing of said contract and shall be prosecuted with such vigor that all the work embraced therein shall be entirely on plated on or before the lat day of Sovember 1946, and the City of Albany shall be deemed to suffer damages to the extend of \$25.00 per day for each and every day the work is delayed beyond such time.

Said contract shall further provide that the said Leonard & Slate Gregon Ltd. shall, promptly as due, make payment to all parties supplying to him labor and material for the prosecution of the hereinabove described work and that we will not permit any lien or claim to be prosecuted against the City of ilbumy for or on account of any labor or material furnished on said work and shall also pay all contributions or amounts due the State Industrial (ceident Fund incurred in the performance of said contract.

ORDINANCE NO. 1741 continued

Section 2. The said Leonard & Slate Cregon Ltd. shall furnish a bond in a sum equal to fifty per cent of the contract price with good and sufficient surety thereon to be approved by the Eayor of the City of albany, we secure the faithful verformance of all the obligations of said contract on the part of the said bidder and particularly on account of any lien or claim for labor or naterial furnished on the part of any purson or persons arising out of such contract.

Said contract shall further provide that should the said contractor fail, reglect or refuse to make proupt payment of any claim for labor, trages, or materials furnished by any person in connection with said contract as said claim becomes due, whether said labor, trages or materials be furnished for said contractor or any sub-contractor, that and in such event the founcil of the City of Albany may pay such claims to the proper claiments and charge the same against funds due or to become due said contractor by reason of said contract.
