A BILL FOR:

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE ERECTION, CONSTRUCTION, EN-LARGELENT, ALTERATION, MIFAIR, MOVING, REFOVAL, CONVERSION, DE-MOLITION, OCCUPANCY, EQUIPMENT, USE, RESOURT, AREA, AND MAINTENIANCE OF BUILDINGS OR STRUCTURES IN THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON; PROVID-ING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF TERRITS AND COLLECTION OF SEES THERMPOR; DICLARING AND ESTABLISHING FIRE DISTRICTS; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THERMOF, AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THERMITH,

THE PROPIE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLICIS:

Section 1. That the purpose of regulating the erection, construction, enlargement, alteration, repair, moving, removal, conversion, demolition, occupancy, equipment, use, height, area, and maintenance of buildings and structures in the City of Albany, Oregon, the Uniform Building Code as now adopted and made effective by the Pacific Coast Building Officials Conference is hereby adopted as and for the building code of the City of Albany, Oregon, said code being hereby specifically referred to and by this reference made a part hereof as though the same were specifically incorporated and set forth herein, and said code is hereby declared to be in full force and effect in so far as the same may be applicable to and made enforceable within the City of Albany, Oregon.

Section 2. This Ordinance and the Uniform Puilding Code, to which reference is made in Section 1 hereof, shall be and become in full force and effect on and after thirty (30) days from its final passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
