A Bill For:

AN ORDINANCE providing for the time and manner of vacating Seventh Street from the west line of Jackson Street to the east line of Railroad Street in the City of albany, Llan County, State of Oregon, and declaring an emergency.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Eayor and Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, are hereby authorized and directed to proceed to vacate Seventh Street from the west line of Jackson Street to the East line of Railroad Street in the City of Albany, Linn County, State of Oregon.

Section 2. The Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon, is hereby authorized and directed to give notice of the vacation of said street hereinabove described by publishing the same in the Albany Democrat Herald, a newspaper of general circulation published in the City of Albany, egon, once each week for four successive weeks, which said notice shall state that the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, will on the 23rd day of April, 1947, at 7:30 o'clock P.M. of said day, at the City Council Chambers of the City of Albany, Oregon, hear objections or remonstrances to the vacation of said street by any person or persons interested therein and particularly by the owners of the real property affected thereby. The Recorder of said City, within five days after the first publication of said notice shall post or cause to be posted at or near each end of said street herein proposed to be vacated a copy of said notice which shall be headed "MOTICE OF STREET VACATION", such notice shall also be posted in at least two conspicuous places within said proposed vacation of said street. The posting and the first day of publication of such notice shall not be less than twenty-eight days before the time of such hearing as hereinabove stated.

Section 5. THEREAS, the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Albany requires that this ordinance shall become immediately effective. THEREFORE, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall become in full force and effect immediately upon its final passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
