## ORDINANCE NO. 1923

A BILL FOR:

AN ORDINANCE to determine the probable cost of certain improvements which the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon has determined to make in "esolution No. 20 adopted by said "ouncil on the 9th day of June 1948, and to make on TWELFTH STREET from the "est line of Elm to the East line of Tottage Street; to ascartain, assess, determine and declare the proportionate share of such probable cost of such improvement of said Street that is assessed upon each lot or part thereof adjacent to said part of said Street to be so improved; to direct the Recorder of said City to enter a statement of such assessment in the Docket of City Liens as provided by the Charter of said City.

WHEREAS on the 25th day of May, 1948, the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon duly adopted a resolution requiring the City Engineer of said tity to make plans and specification for the improvement of TARLETH STEEL, from the West line of Elm Street to the East line of Cottige Street, in the following manner to-wit:

By grading and graveling.
By laying and constructing concrete gutters, where needed.
By constructing concrete purbs and sidewalks, where needed.
By installing a proper drainage system.

and for the estimates of the work to be done on said portion of said Street and the probable cost thereof and requiring that such plans, specifications, estimates and probable cost be filed in the Redorder's office of said City, said Resolution being endorsed, "Resolution No. 11" and adopted on the 25th day of May, 1948.

WHEREAS the City Engineer of said City of Albany pursuant to said Resolution No. 11 made plans, specifications and estimates as directed by the said resolution for the improvement of said Street in the manner specified in said Resolution No. 11 and filed said plans, specifications and estimates in the Recorder's office of said City on the 10th day of June 1948.

WHEREAS the Council on the 9th day of June 1948 by Resolution No. 20 duly adopted by said Council, determined and resolved that it deemed it expedient and that said Council proposed to improve TOLFTH STREET from the West line of Elm to the East line of Cottage Street in the manner provided in said Resolution No. 20, and :

WHEREAS, in and by said Resolution No. 20 adopted as aforesaid by the Council the Recorder of said City was duly ordered and directed by the said Council to give notice of said proposed improvement of said Street as provided by the Charter of said City and:

WHEREAS, the Recorder in pursuance of said order and direction of the Council of said ity of Albany did any give no ice of said proposed improvement of said Street in the manner provided by the Charter of said City and:

WHEREAS, the said Council in and by said Resolution No. 20 ascertained and determined the total probable cost of making said improvement of said Street to be paid by the owners of the real property adjacent to said portion of said Street to be improved as specified in said Resolution No. 20 to be the sum of \$6,300.00

## THEREFORE

THE PEOPLY OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That TWELFTH STREET from the West line of Elm to the East line of Cottage Street, be improved as follows:

By grading and graveling.
By laying and constructing concrete gutters, where needed.
By constructing concrete curbs and sidewalks, where needed.
By installing a proper drainage system.

all in accordance with said Resolution No. 20 and the plans and specifications for said improvement filed by the City Engineer with the Recorder of said lity of Albany, Oregon on the 9th day of June, 1948.

Section 2. That the robable cost of making said improvements of said Street in the namer heretofors determined by the Council of Albany in and by Resolution No 20 to be paid by the owners of the real property adjacent to said portion of said Street is hereby declared to be thesum of 06,300.00.

Section 3. That the proportionate share of said probable cost of said improvement of said Street assessed upon each lot or part thereof adjacent to said part of said Street to be improved as aforesaid and as determined by said Council in and by said Resolution No. 20 is hereby ascertained and declared to be the sum set and placed immediately after the separate descriptions of each of such lots or parts theref as follows:
