By grading and graveling said streets. By laying and constructing concrete gutters. By constructing concrete curbs and sidewalks, where needed.

By installing a proper drainage system.

and for the estimates of the work to be done on said portion of said Streets and the probable cost thereof and requirin. that such plans, socifications, estimates and probable cost be filed in the Recorder's office of said City, said Resolution being endorsed "Resolution No. 9" and adopted the 25th day of May, 1948.

WHEREAS the City Engineer of said City of Albany pursuant to said Resolution No. 9 made plans, specifications and estimates as directed by the said resolution for the improvement of s id Streets, in the manner specified in said Resolution No. 9 and filed said plans, specifications and estimates in the Recorder's office of said City on the 15th day of June, 1948.

WHEREAS the Council on the 9th day of June 1948 by Resolution No. 26 duly adopted by said Council, determined and resolved that it dee med it expedient and that said Council proposed to improve WINDT STREET between lucen Avenue and 19th Avenue, and ETCHTEETTH AVENUE FROM Maple to Elm Streets, and MAPLE STREET from Wheen Avenue to 19th Avenue, in the manner provided in said Resolution No. 26 and:

WHEREAS, in and by said Resolution No. 26 adopted as aforesaid by the Council the Recorder of said City was duly ordered and directed by said Council to give notice of said proposed improvement of said Street as provided by the Charter of said City and:

WHEREAS, the Recorder in pursuance of said order and direction of the Council of said Ciry of Albany did duly give notice of said proposed improvement of said street in the manner provided by the Charter of said City and:

WHEREAS, the said Council in and by said Resolution No. 26 ascertained and determined the total probable cost of making said improvement of said Streets to be paid by the owners of the real property adjacent to said portion of said Streets to be improved as specifiedd in said Resolution No. 26 to be the sum of \$12,134.00

THEREFORE

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBINY DO CRDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That WALKUT STRUTT, between Queen Avenue and 19th Avenue and SIGHTZENTH AVILUE from Maple to Elm Street, and MAPLE STREET from Queen Avenue to 15th Avenue, in the City of Albany, Oregon, be improved as follows:

By grading and graveling said streets.
 By layin and constructing concrete gutters.

By constructing concrete surbs and sidewalks, where needed.

By installing a proper draininge system.

all in a cordance with said Resolution No. 26 and the plans and specifications for said improvement filed by the City Engineer with the Recorder of said City of Albany, Oregon on the 10th day of June 1946.

Section 2. That the probable cost of making said improvement of said Street in the manner heretofore determined by the Council of Albany, in and by Resolution No. 26 to be paid by the owners of the real property adjacent to said portion of said Streets is hereby declared to be the sum of \$12,134.00.

Section 3. That the proportionate share of said probable cost of said improvement of said Streets assessed upon each bit or part thereof adjacent to said part of said Streets to be improved as aforesaid and as determined by said Council in and by said Resolution No. 26 is hereby ascertained and declared to be the sum set and placed immediately after the separate descriptions of each of such lots or parts the sof as follows:
