A BILL PORT

AN ORDINANCE to determine the probable cost of certain improvement which the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon has determined to make in Resolution No. 30 adopted by said Council on the 9th day of June 1946 and to make on COLUMBUS STREET from the South line of the Old Pacific Highway to the North line of 99E; to ascertain, assess, determine, and declare the proportionate share of such probable cost of such improvement of said Streat that is assessed upon each lot or part thereof adjacent to said part of said Streat to be so improved; to direct the Recorder of said City to exter a statement of such assessement in the Docket of City Liens as provided by the Charter of said City.

WHENEAS on the 25th day of May 1948, the Council of the City of "Ibany, Oregon duly adopted a resolution requiring the City Engineer of said City to make plans and specifications for the improvement of COLUMNUS STREET from the south line of the Old Pacific Highway to the North line of 99E in the following manner to-wit:

By grading and graveling said street.
 By installing concrete curbs and gutters, where necessary.
 By installing a proper drainage system.

and for the estimates of the work to be done on said portion of said Street and the probable cost thereof and requiring that such plans and specifications, estimates and probable cost be filed in the Recorder's office of said City, said Resolution being endorsed, "Resolution No. 17" and adopted the 9th day of June 1948.

WHEREAS the City Engineer of said City of Albany pursuant to said Resolution No. 17 made plans, specifications and estimates as directed by the said resolution for the improvement of said Street in the manner specified in said Resolution No. 17 and filed said plans, specifications and estimates in the Recorder's office of said City on the 10th day of June 1948.

WHEREAS the Council on the 9th day of June 1948 by Resolution No. 30 duly adopted by s.id Council, determined and resolved that it deemed it expedient and that said Council proposed to improve COUNCIUS STREET from the South line of Old Pacific Highway to the North line of 99E in the manner provided in said Resolution No. 30 and:

WHEREAS, in and by said Resolution No. 30 adopted as aforeshid by the Council the Recorder of said City was duly ordered and directed by said Council to giv: notice of said proposed improvement of said Street as provided by the Charter of said City and:

WHEREAS, the Recorder in pursuance of said order and direction of the Council of said City of Albany aid duly give notice of said proposed improvement of said Street in the manner provided by the Charter of said City and:

WHEREAS, the said Council in and by said Resolution No. 30 ascertained and determined the total probable cost of making said improvement of said Street to be paid by the owners of the real property adjacent to said portion of said Street to be improved as specified in said Resolution No. 30 to be the sum of \$6,724.00.

## THEREFORE

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That COLUMBUS STREET in the City of albany, Oregon from the South line of the Old Pacific Highway to the North line of 99E be improved as follows:

1. By grading and graveling said street.

By installing concrete curbs and gutters, where necessary.
 By installing a proper drainage system.

all in accordance with said Resolution No. 30 and the plans and specifications for said improvement filed by the City Engineer with the Recorder of said City of Albany, Gregon on the 10th day of June 1946.

Section 2. That the probable cost of making said improvement of said street in the manner heretofore determined by the Council of Albany in and by Resolution No. 30 to be paid by the owners of the real property adjacent to said portion of said Street is hereby declar d to be the sum of \$6,724.00.

Section 3. That the proportionate share of said probable cost of said improvement of said Street assessed upon each lot or part thereof adjacent to said part of said Street to be improved as aforeshid and as determined by said Council in and by said Resolution No. 30 is hereby ascertained and declared to be the sum of set and placed immediately after the separate descriptions of each of such lots or parts thereof as follows:

DESCRIPTION OF EACH LOT OR PAR THEREOF ADJACENT TO SAID IMPROVE ENT OF SAID STREET.
