and for the estimates of the work to be done on sail portion of said Street and the probable cost thereof and requiring that uch plans, specifications, estimates and probable cost be filed in the Recorder's office of sail City, said Resolution being endorsed, "Resolution No. 3" and adopted May 25, 1048.

WHEREAS, the City Engineer of said City of albany pursuant to said Resolution No. 27 made plans, specifications and estimates as directed by the said resolutionfor the improvement of said Street in the manner specified in said Resolution No. 3 and filed said plans, specifications and estimates in the Recorder's office of said City on the 10th day of June 1948.

WHEREAS the Council on the 9th day of June 1948 by Resolution No. 27 duly adopted by said Council, determined and resolved that it deemed it expedient and that said Council proposed to improve RITIROLD STREET between 1st and 7th Streets in the manner provided in said Resolution No. 27 and:

WHEREAS, in and by said Resolution No. 27 adopted as accressed by the Council the Recorder of said City was duly ordered and directed by said Council to give notice of said proposed improvement of said Street as provided by the Charter of Said City and:

WHEREAS, the Recorder on pursuance of said order and direction of the Council of said City of alpany did duly give notice of said proposed improvement of said Street in the manner provided by the Charter of said City and:

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBAMY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That RAILROAD STREET between 1st and 7th Streets in the City of Albany, Oregon, be improved as follows:

By grading and graveling said street.
By installing concrete curbs and gutters, where necessary.
By installing a proper drainage system.
By surfacing said street with suitable saterial to make a permanent improved street.

all in accordance with said Resolution No. 27 and the plans and specifications for said improvement filed by the Jity Engineer with the Recorder of said City of Albany, Oregon on the 10th day of June, 1948.

Section 2. That the probable cost of making said improvement of said Street in the manner heretofore determined by the ounciloof Albany in and by Resolution No. 27 to be paid by the owners of the real property adjacent to said portion of said Street is hereby declared to be the sum of \$11,266.00.

Section 3. That the proportionate share of said probable cost of said improvement of said Street assessed upon each lot or part thereof adjacent to said part of said Street to be improved as aforeshid and as determined by said Council in and by said Resolution No. 27 is hereby ascertained and declared to be the sum set and placed immediately after the separate descriptions of each of such lots or parts thereof as follows:
