ORDINANCE NO. 1938

A BILL POR

AN ORDINANCE to appropriate \$1676.81 out of the General Fund and \$17782.33 out of the Fire Equip. Sink Fund of the City of Albany to be used in payment for three trucks, and authorizing payment in accordance with the terms of this ordinance.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That there be and there is hereby appropriated from the Fire Equipment Sinking Fund of the City of Albany the amount of \$16,157.33, it being the price heretofore agreed upon with the Mac International Truck Corporation as shown by the invoice therefore now on file in the office of the City Recorder of said City.

Section 2. That there be and there is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the Sity of Albany the amount of S1,676.31 it being the price heretofore agreed upon with the Missen Motor Company as shown by the invoice therefore now on file in the office of the City Recorder of said City.

Section 3. That there be and there is hereby appropriated from the Fire Equipment Sinking Fund of the City of Albany the amount of \$100.00, it being the amount deposited by Harold Fisher, with order, with the 0. K. Auto Sales, as shown by the invoice therefore now on file in the office of the City Recorder of said City.

Section 4. That there be and there is hereby appropriated from the Fire Equipment Sinking Fund of the City of Albany the amount of \$1,525.00, it being the price heretofore agreed upon with the 0. K. Auto Sales, as shown by the invoice therefore now on file in the office of the City Recorder of said City.

Section 5. Whereas, the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Albany require that this ordinance become immediately effective, therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall become in full force and effect upon its final passage by the Council and approval by the liayor.
