



ORDINANCE NO. 1950

A BILL

For an Ordinance to determine the final cost of certain improvement which the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon has determined to make in Resolutions No. 34 and 35 adopted by said Council on the 23 Day of June 1948 and to ~~PAVE~~ PAVE MAPLE STREET from the So. line of 11th street to the No. line of 15th Street; to ascertain, assess, determine and declare the proportionate share of such cost of such improvement of said street that is assessed upon each lot or part thereof adjacent to said part of said street to be so improved; to direct the Recorder of said City to enter a statement of such assessment in the Docket of City Liens as provided by the Charter of said City.

WHEREAS, on the 23rd day of June 1948, the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon duly adopted a resolution requiring the City Engineer of said City to make plans and specifications for the improvement of MAPLE STREET From the So. line of 11th Street to the No. line of 15th Street, in the following manner to-wit:

- 1. By installing suitable hard surface material

and for the estimates of the work to be done on said portion of said Street and the probable cost thereof and requiring that such plans, specifications, estimates and probable cost be filed in the Recorder's office of said City, said Resolution being endorsed "Resolution No. 34 and adopted the 23rd day June 1948.

WHEREAS the City Engineer of said City of Albany pursuant to said Resolution No. 34 made plans, specifications and estimates as directed by the said resolution for the improvement of said Streets, in the manner specified in said Resolution No. 34 and filed said plans, specifications and estimates in the Recorder's office of the City on the 23rd day of June 1948

WHEREAS the Council on the 23 day of June 1948 by Resolution No. 35 duly adopted by said Council, determined and resolved that it deemed it expedient and that said council proposed to improve MAPLE STREET from the So. Line of 11th Street to the No. line of 15th Street, in the manner provided in said Resolution No. 35 and:

WHEREAS in and by said Resolution No. 35 adopted as aforesaid by the Council the Recorder of said City was duly ordered and directed by said Council Charter of said City and:

WHEREAS, the Recorder in pursuance of said order and direction of the Council of said City of Albany did duly give notice of said proposed improvement of said Street in the manner provided by the Charter of said City and:

WHEREAS the said Council in and by said Resolution No. 35 ascertained and determined the total probable cost of making said improvement of said Streets to be paid by the owners of the real property adjacent to said portion of said Street to be improved as specified in said Resolutions No. 34 and 35 to be the sum of \$ 8915.30.

THEREFORE

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Maple Street from the So. line of 11th Street to the No. line of 15th Street, in the City of Albany, Oregon, be improved as follows:

- 1. By installing suitable hard surface material

all in accordance with said Resolution No. 35 and the plans and specifications for said improvement filed by the City Engineer with the Recorder of said City of Albany, Oregon on the 23 day of June 1948.

Section 2. That the probable cost of making said improvement of said Street in the manner heretofore determined by the Council of Albany, in and by Resolution No. 35 to be paid by the owners of the real property adjacent to said portion of said Street is hereby declared to be the sum of \$8915.30.

Section 3. That the proportionate share of said final cost of said improvement of said Street assessed upon each lot or part thereof adjacent to said part of said Street to be improved as aforesaid and as determined by said Council in and by said Resolution No. 35, is hereby ascertained and declared to be the sum set thereof as follows:
