A BILL FOR:

AN ORDUNICE DECLARING A SURPLUS AND A DEFICIT ON ACCUMIT OF THE IMPROVEMENT OF WALNUT STREET BETWEEN QUEEN AVENUE AND 19th AVENUE;

18th AVENUE FROM MAPLE STREET TO BLM STREETAND HAPLE STREET FROM QUEEN STREET TO 16th STREET, IN THE CITY OF ALBANY, LI N COUNTY, OREGON, BY KEESLER CONSTRUCTION CO., AND DIRECTING THE RECORDER OF SAID CITY TO PLACE TO THE GREDIT OR DEGIT OF THE SEVERAL OWNERS OF THE VARIOUS PARCELS OF REAL ESTATE ADJACENT TO SAID IN PROVENENT HERETOFORE ASSESSED AND ENTERED ON THE RECORD IN THE DOCKET OF CITY LIENS OF THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON FOR THE MAKING OF SAID IMPROVEMENT, THEIR PROPORTIONATE SHARE OF SUCH SURPLUS OR DEFICIT.

THE PEOPLE OF TH' CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That a surplus of 1771.81 and a deficit of 3685.42 is hereby ascertained and declared to exast upon the completion of the contract heretofore entered into, by and between the City of Albany, Oregon and Keebler Construction Co. for the improvement of Walnut Street between Queen Avenue and 19th Avenue; 18th Avenue from Maple Street to Elm Street and Raple Street from Queen to 18th Street in the City of Albany, Oregon, and in favor of the several owners of the variousparcels of real estate adjacent to said improvement heretofore assessed for the making of said improvement.

Section 2. The Recorder of the City of Albany is hereby directed to enter in the Bocket of City Liens for said City, in the surplus column and deficit column thereof, in the sum of 3771.81 and \$665.42 respectively, based upon the several amounts heretofore assessed for making such improvement, and entered therein to defray the cost of the improvement, of said street, sied surplus and deficit parcels of real estate, and in the sums as follows, to-wit:
