

ORDINANCE NO. 1970

AN ORDINANCE TO RE-APPORTION CERTAIN BUDGET ITEMS IN THE 1948-1949 BUDGET.

WHEREAS, the budget of the City Engineer has had some expenses this year not anticipated, such as enlarging his office space and the delayed payment for a purchase of a car long on order, and,

WHEREAS, the Sewers labor and expense and emergency budget accounts apparently have a surplus over and above anticipated needs

NOW, THEREFORE, The people of the city of Albany do ordain as follows:

That the following transfers in budget credits be made:

FROM:

Sewers Labor	\$-1,000.00	
Sewers Expense	1,000.00	
Engineer's Salary	160.00	
Emergency	<u>550.00</u>	\$2,710.00

TO:

Engineer Expense	2,710.00
