ORDINANCE NO. 1988

AM ORDIVANCE providing for the time and manner of improvementof Water Street from east line of Lyon to west line of Ferry Street in the City of Albany, Oregon providing how the cost of such is provement shall be paid, the penalty or damage to the City of Albany by the person or persons making said improvement if the same shall not be completed on the tire agreed upon, and the giving of a good and sufficient bond for the faithful performance of the work of such improvement, and providing for the giving by the Recorder of said City of notice for bids for the completion of said improvement, and declaring an emergency.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That WATER STREET from east line of Lyon to west line of Ferry Street in the City of Albany, Oregon be improved in the following manner, to-wit:

By grading said street to the proper sub-grade.

By paving with suitable hard surface.
By laving and constructing concrete gutters where necessary.
By constructing concrete curbs and sidewalks where necessary. 3.

Said improvement shall be made in accordance with the Charter and Ordinances of the City of Albany, Oregon, and the plans, specifications and estimates of Harold Poling, Engineer, for the improvement of said street filed in the office of the Recorder of said City of Albany on the 23d day of March, 1949.

The cost of making of said improvement shall be said out of the funds to be collected and arising upon and out of the assessments hereafter to be made, ascertained and declared by the Council of the City of Albany on the lots and parts of lots adjacent to said portion of said street so to be improved as hereinabove described and especially and particularly benefited thereby, as provided by the Charter of said city of Albany.

Said improvement shall be completed by the 15th May of September 1949.

All bids for themaking of said improvement deemed unreasonable by the Council may be rejected.

Any person, firm or corporation with whom any contract may be entered into by the City o' Albany for themaking of said in provement shall, before commencing said improvement and at the time of signing were contract, make, execute and teliver to said City a good and sufficient bond with sufficient surety thereon to be approved by the Mayor of the City of Albany in a sum equal to fifty per cent of the amount to be paid under such contract for the faithful performance thereof.

Section . If the person, firm or corporation entering into any contract with the City of Albany to make said increvenent shall not complete the same within the time mentioned and specified in such contract, the City of Albany shall be deemed to suffer damages in account the reof in the amount of 5.00 per day for each and every day the commission of sold work is delayed beyond the time stated in such contract, we can appear t shall be paid by such contractor doing the work at the completion the red unless the time of the completion of said improvement be extended by the Courcil.

The Recorder of the City of Albany is hereby rdered and Section 3. directed to immediately give proper natice for olds formaking of said in-provement by publishing such notice ten days in the Albany Democrat-Herlah, a newspaper of general direction published in the City of Albany, fully describing in said notice the time and manner of doing said work of improving said portion of said streets.

Section 4. Inasmuch as the provisions of this ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, mealth an safet of the citizens of the City of Albany, Oregon, an emergency is nered declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect in mediate wumon its passage by the Council and its approval as the council as the counc
