

ORDINANCE NO. 2006

AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1422 an ORDINANCE REGULATING TRAFFIC ON THE STREETS AND PUBLIC WAYS OF THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON; PROVIDING FOR TRAFFIC SIGNS, MARKERS AND SIGNALS; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS HEREOF; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

The people of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:

That Section 71 of said ordinance shall be amended by adding thereto part (d) as follows:

(d) Parking from 2:00 A.M. to 6:00 A.M. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to allow any vehicle to stand at any time between the hours of 2:00 o'clock and 6:00 o'clock in the morning on the following described streets within the City of Albany, Oregon:

Water Avenue from Washington Street to Baker Street;

First Avenue from Washington Street to Railroad Street;

Second Avenue from Washington Street to Railroad Street;

Third Avenue from Washington Street to Montgomery Street;
Washington Street from First Avenue to Third Avenue

Ferry Street from Water Avenue to Third Avenue;

Broadalbin Street from Water Avenue to Third Avenue;

Ellsworth Street from Water Avenue to Third Avenue;

Lyon Street from Water Avenue to Third Avenue;

Baker Street from First Avenue to Third Avenue;

Montgomery Street from First Avenue to Third Avenue;

Railroad Street from First Avenue to Second Avenue.

It shall be unlawful for any person to violate any of the provisions of this ordinance. Such conviction for the violation of this ordinance shall be governed and punished under the provisions of Section 84 of said Ordinance No. 1422.
