As Community providing for the time and minner of improvement of Eighteenth Avenue from Elm to the west line of Maple, and Manut from the south line of Cueen to the north line of Mineteenth.

providing how the cost of such improvement shall be paid, the panulty or damage to the City of Albiny by the parsen or persons acking such improvement if the same shall not be completed on the time agreed upon, and the giving of a good and sufficient bond for the faithful performance of the work of such improvement, and providing for the giving by the Recorder of the said City of notice for bids for the completion of said improvement, and declaring an emergency.

THE PROPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBUST DO GRDAIN AS POLLOWS:

Section 1. That Eighteenth Avenue from Elm to the west line of Maple, and Walnut from the south line of Queen to the north line of Nineteenth

be improved in the following manner, tearite Levelling course

Levelling course Hard surfacing Drainage

Said improvement shall be made in accordance with the Charter and Ordinances of the City of Albany, Oregon and the plans, specifications and estimates for the improvement of said street filed in the office of the Recorder of the said City of Albany on the lith day of March, 1951.

The cost of making of said improvement shall be paid out of the funds to be collected and arising upon and out of the assessments hereafter to be made, ascertained and declared by the Council of the City of Albany on the lots and parts of lots adjacent to said portion of said street so to be improved as hereinabove described and especially and particularly benefited thereby, as provided by the Charter of said City of Albany.

Said improvement shall be completed by the 15th of September, 1951. The City Council reserves the right to reject any and all bids.

Any person, firm or corporation with whom any contract may be entered into by the City of Albany for the maining of eaid improvement shall, before commencing eaid improvement and at the time of signing such contract, make, execute and deliver to said City a good and sufficient bond with sufficient surety thereon to be approved by the Mayor of the City of Albany in a sum equal to firty pur semb of the amount to be paid under such contract for the faithful purformance thereof.

Section 2. If the parson, firm or corporation entering into any contract with the City of Albany to make said improvement shall not complete the same within the time mentioned and specified in such contract, the City of Albany shall be deemed to suffer damages on account thereof in the amount of \$25.00 per day for each and every day the completion of said work is delayed beyond the time stated in such contract, which amount shall be paid by such contractor doing the work at the completion thereof, unless the time of the completion of said improvement be extended by the council.

Section 3. The Recorder of the City of Albary is hereby ordered and directed to immediately give proper notice for bids for making of said improvement by publishing such notice ten days in the Albany Democrat-Herald, a newspaper of general circulation published in the City of Albany, fully describing in said notice the time and manner of doing said work of improving said portion of said street.

Section 4. Inasmuch as the provisions of this ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Albany, Oregon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and its approval by the Mayor of the City of Albany.
