AN ORDINATE TO MAKE, DETENDING AND DECLARE THE AMOUNT OF TAKES TO BE LEVIED UPON THE CURRENT ASSESSMENT AND TAX ROLL FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 1951 AND MIDTIO JUNE 30, 1952, AND TO MAKE A SEPARATE APPROPRIATION FOR EACH OFFICE OR OFFICER, DEPARTMENT, BUILDING OR OTHER PURPOSE IN CONNECTION WITH THE OPERATION OF THE CITY OF ALEMY, OREGON, AND THAT THE AMOUNT OF TAXES SO LEVIED ARE APPROPRIATED FOR EXPENDITURE: AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Section 1.
