ORDINANCE NO. 2343

AT CHAINAICE providing for the time and manner of improvement of

Fourth Avenue from Erwine to Columbus

providing how the cost of such improvement shall be paid, the penalty or damage to the City of Albany by the person or persons making such improvement if the same shall not be completed on the time agreed upon, and the giving of a good and sufficient bond for the faithful performance of the work of such improvement, and providing for the giving by the Recorder of the said City of notice for bids for the completion of said improvement, and declaring an emergency.

THE PREPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY UG ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Fourth Avenue from Ermine to Columbus

be improved in the following manner, to-wit:

- Grade and gravel
 Curb and gutter
- 3. Sidewalk
- 4. Drainage

Said haprovesset shall be made in accordance with the Charter and Ordinances of the City of Albamy, Oregon and the plans, specifications and estimates for the improvement of said street filed in the office of the Recorder of the said City of Albany on the 26th day of March, 1952.

The enut of making of said improvement small be paid out of the funds to be collected and arising upon and out of the assessments hereafter to be made, ascertained and leclared by the Council of the City of albany on the lots and parts of lots adjacent to said portion of said othest so to be improved as hereinabove described and veroscially and particularly bunefited thereby, as provided by the Charter of maid City of Albany,

Said dasprovement shall be completed by the 15th day of September, 1952. The City Council reserves the right to reject any and all bids.

Any person, firm or corporation with whom any contract may be entered into by the City of albany for the making of said improvement shall, before communing said improvement and at the time of signing such contract, make, execute and deliver to said tity a good and sufficient bond with sufficient surety thereon to be approved by the mayor of the City of Albany in a sum equal to fifty per cent of the amount to be paid under such contract for the faithful performance thereof.

Section 2. If the person, firm or corporation entering into any contract with the City of Albany to make said improvement shall not complete the same within the time mentioned and specified in such contract, the City of Albany shall be desmed to suffer camages on account thereof in the amount of 25.00 per day for each are every way the completion of said work is delayed beyond the time stated in such contract, which ascent shall be paid by such contractor duing the work at the completion thereof, unless the time of the completion of said improvement be extended by the council.

Section 3. The Hecoraer of the City of Albany is hereby ordered and directed to immediately give propor notice for bids for making of said improvement by publishing such notice ten days in the Albany Associated Herald, a newspaper of general circulation sublished in the City of Albany, fully describing in said notice the time and memor of dalay said work of improving said portion of said street.

Section 4. Instant as the provisions of this ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Albery, Orogon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and its approval by the Mayor of the City of Albany.
