ORDINANCE NO. 2348

A ORDINANCE providing for the time and manner of improvement of Eighth Avenue from Clay street to Ermine street

providing how the cost of such improvement shall be paid, the penalty or damage to the City of Albery by the person or persons making such improvement if the sees shall not be completed on the time agreed upon, and the giving of a good and sufficient bond for the faithful performance of the work of such improvement, and providing for the giving by the Recorder of the said City of notice for bids for the ompletion of said improvement, and declaring an emergency.

THE PLOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY OC ORDAIN AS POLICUS:

Section 1. That Eighth Avenue from Clay street to Ermine street

be improved in the following manner, to-wit:

- Grade and gravel
 Curb and gutter
- 3. Sidewalk

Said improvement shall be made in accordance with the Charter and Ordinances of the Uit; of Albany, Oregon and the plans, specifications and estimates for the impro sent. I said street filed in the office of the Recorder of the said City of Alben; on the lotte day of Marchy 1952,

The on the of resting of said improvement shall be pain out of the funds to be collected and and sing upon and out of the assessments hereafter to be made, ascertained and replaced by the Council of the City of Albany on the lots and parts of lots adjace at to easid portion of said street so to be improved as hereinabove described and socially and particularly bonefited thereby, as provided by the Charter of the lity of Albany.

Said improvement shall be completed by the 15th day of September, 1952. The City Council reserves the right to reject any and all bids.

Amy person, firm or corporation with whom any contract may be entered into by the City of albany for the making of said improvement shall, before commencing said improvement and at the time of signing such contract, make, execute and deliver to said City a good and sufficient bond with sufficient surety thereon to be approved by the hayor of the City of Albany in a cum equal to fifty per cent of the emount to be paid under such contract for the faithful performance thereof.

Section 4. If the person, firm or corporation entering into any contract with the City of albany to make usid improvement shall not complete the same within the time mentioned and epecified in such contract, the City of Albany shall be demon to suffer unmages on account thereof in the amount of 225.00 per day for each and every way the completion of said work is delayed beyond the time stated in such contract, which amount shall be paid by such contractor desing the work at the completion thereof, unless the time of the completion of said improvement be extended by the council.

Section 3. The Recorder of the City of Alberry is hereby ordered and directed to immediately give proper notice for bids for making of said improvement by publishing such notice ten days in the Albany descerat-derald, a newspaper of general directables sublished in the City of Albany, fully describing in said notice the time and manner of doing said work of improving said portion of said street.

Section 4. Inassuch as the provisions of this ordinance are necessary for the immiliate preservation of the perce, health and mafety of the citizens of the City of albany, Oregon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and its approved by the Mayor of the City of Albany.
