GROTHANCE NO. 2356

AN COLUMNICE providing for the time and summer of improvement of 19th Avenue from Els to Walnut

providing how the cost of such improvement shall be paid, the penalty or damage to the City of Albany by the person or persons making such improvement if the same shall not be completed on the time agreed upon, and the giving of a good and sufficient bond for the faithful performance of the work of such improvement, and providing for the giving by the Recorder of the said City of notice for bids for the completion of said improvement, and declaring an emergency.

THE PROPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DC ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That 19th Avenue from Elm to Walnut

be improved in the fallowing manner, to-dit:

- 1. Grade and gravel
- 2. Asphalt concrete
- 3. Curb and gutter
- 4. Sidewalk

Said improvement shall be made in accordance with the Charter and Ordinances of the City of Allmay, Oregon and the plans, specifications and estimates for the improvement of said street filed in the office of the Recorder of the said City of Albany on the 26th day of Barch, 1952.

The cost of making of said improvement shall be paid out of the funds to be collected and arising upon and out of the assessments hereafter to be made, ascertained and declared by the Council of the City of Albany on the lots and parts of lots adjacent to said portion of said street so to be improved as hereinabove described and especially and particularly benefited thereby, as provided by the Charter of said City of Albany.

Said improvement shall be completed by the 15th day of September, 1952. The City Council reserves the right to reject any and all bids.

Any person, firm co-corporation with whom any contract may be entered into by the City of albeing for the making of said improvement shall, before commencing said improvement and at the time of signing such contract, make, ascente and deliver to said City a good and sufficient bond with sufficient surety thereon to be approved by the kayor of the City of Albany in a sum equal to fifty per cent of the amount to be paid under such contract for the Taithful performance thereof.

Section 2. If the person, firm or corporation entering into any contract with the City of Albery to make said improvement shall not complete the same within the time mentioned and specified in such contract, the City of Albany shall be deced to suffer changes on account thereof in the amount of ,25,00 per day for each and every day the completion of said work is delayed beyond the time stated in such contract, which amount shall be paid by such contractor deing the work at the completion thereof, unless the time of the completion of said improvement be extended by the council.

Section 3. The Mccorder of the City of Albany is hereby ordered and directed to investigately give proper notice for bids for making of said improvement by publishing sech motice ten days in the Albany Democrat-Herald, a newspaper of general circulation published in the City of Albany, fully describing in said notice the time ent manner of doing said work of improving said portion of said street.

Section 4. Instruct as the provisions of this ordinance are necessary for the institute preservation of the peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of albumy, Oregon; an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and its approval by the Mayor of the City of Albany.
