All CHICAGO providing for the time and memor of improvement of

Queen Avenue from the east line of Elm street to 99E change has the cost of such improvement shall be paid, the penalty or demage the City of Albert by the person or persons making such improvement if the shall not be completed on the time agreed upon, and the giving of a good sufficient boost for the faithful performance of the work of such improvement providing for the giving by the Recorder of the said City of notice for bide the completion of said improvement, and declaring an emergency.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DC ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section L. That Queen Avenue from the east line of Elm street to 99E

be improved in the following manner, to-writ:

- 1. Curb and gutters
 2. Sidewalks
- 3. Drainage

Said improvement shall be made in accordance with the Charter and Ordinances of the City of albany, Oregon and the plans, specifications and estimates for the improvement of said street filed in the office of the Recorder of the said City of Albeny on the 2cth day of Harch, 1952.

The cost of making of said improvement shall be paid out of the funds to be collected and arising upon and out of the assessments hereafter to be made, ascertained and declared by the Council of the City of albany on the lots and parts of lots adjacent to said portion of said street so to be improved as hereinabove described and especially and particularly benefited thereby, as provided by the Charter of said City of Albany.

Said improvement shall be completed by the 15th day of September, 1952. The City Council reserve the right to reject any and all bids.

Any person, fire. or corporation with whom any contract may be entered into by the City of albany for the making of said improvement shell, before commencing said improvement and at the time of signing such contract, make, execute and deliver to said City a good and sufficient bond with sufficient surety thereon to be approved by the Kayor of the City of Albany in a sum equal to fifty per cent of the amount to be paid under such contract for the faithful performance thereof.

Section 2. If the person, firm or corporation entering into any contract with the City of Albany to make said improvement shall not complete the same within the time mentioned and specified in such contract, the City of Albany shall be deemed to suffer damages on account thereof in the amount of 125.00 per day for each and every may the completion of said work is delayed beyond the time stated in such contract, which shount shall be paid by such contractor doing the work at the completion thereof, unless the time of the completion of said improvement be extended by the council.

Section 3. The Recorder of the City of Albany is hereby ordered and directed to immediately give proper notice for hids for making of said improvement by publishing such notice ten days in the Albany numberal-Herald, a newspaper of general circulation published in the City of Albany, fully describing in said notice the time and sensity of doing said work of improving said portion of said street.

Section 4. Inasmuch as the provisions of this ordinance are necessary for the issuadiate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Albany, Oregon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and its approval by the Mayor of the City of Albany.
