

ORDINANCE NO. 2368

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR THE PURCHASE OF 1,000 POUNDS WARFARIN RAT KILLER FROM MULLEN'S SEED STORE.

WHEREAS, the Recorder did heretofore advertise for bids for 1,000 pounds Warfarin Rat Killer,

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Albany at a regular council meeting on the 23rd day of April, 1952, did by motion duly seconded and passed awarded the contract for the 1,000 pounds Warfarin Rat Killer to Mullen's Seed Store.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

That the Mayor and Acting City Manager of the City of Albany are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Mullen's Seed Store of Albany, Oregon for the purchase of 1,000 pounds Warfarin Rat Killer at the bid price in the sum of \$464.00 F.O.B., Albany, Oregon.

Inasmuch as the passage of this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Albany, Oregon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and its approval by the Mayor of the City of Albany.
