IN THE CITY OF ALBANY, CREGON: TO ASCERTAIN, ASSESS, DETERMINE AND DECLARS THE PROPORTIONATE SHARE OF SUCH PROBABLE COST OF SUCH IMPROVEMENT OF SAID STREET TO BE SO IMPROVED, TO DIRECT THE RECORDER OF SAID CITY TO ENTER A STATEMENT OF SUCH ASSESSMENT IN THE DOCKET OF CITY LIENS AS PROVIDED BY TO DETERMINE AND DECLARE CHARTER OF SAID CITY.

WHEREAS on the 12th day of March, 1952, the Council of the City of Albany, Oragon duly adopted a resolution requiring the City Engineer of said City to make plans and specifications for the improvement of Madison Street from Water Avenue to Willamette River

in the following manner, to-wit:

1. Grade and gravel

Asphalt concrete

and for the satimates of the work to be done on said portion of said street and the probable cost thereof and requiring that such plans, specifications, and estimates and probable cost be filed in the Recorder's office of said City, said resolution being endorsed "Resolution No. 231A" and adopted 12th day of March, 1952.

WHEREAS the City Engineer of said City of Albany pursuant to said Resolution No.231A made plans, specifications and estimates as directed by the said resolution for the improvement of said street in the manner specified in said Resolution No. 231A and filed said plans, specifications and estimates in the Recorder's office of said City on the 26th day of March. 1952.

WHEREAS the Council on the 26th day of March, 1952 by Resolution

No. 2318 duly adopted by said Council, determined and resolved that it deemed it expedient and that said Council, proposed to improve

Madison Street from Water Avenue to Willamette River

in the manner provided in said Resolution No. 231B , and

WHEREAS the Recorder in pursuance of said order and direction of the Council of said City did duly give notice of said proposed improvement.

WHEREAS the Council in and by said Resolution No. 231B ascertained
and ditermined the total probable cost of making said improvement of said
street to be paid by the owners of the real property adjacent to said

THEREFORE

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS POLLOWS:

Section 1 That Madison Street from Water Avenue to Willamette River

in the City of Albany, Oregon be improved as follows:

1. Grade and gravel 2. Asphalt concrete

all in accordance with said Resolution No. 231B and the plane and specifica-

tions for said improvement filed by the City Engineer with the Recorder of said City of Albany, Oregon on the 26th day of March, 1952.

Section 2. That the probable cost of making said improvement of said street in the menner heretofore determined by the Council of Albany in and by Resolution No.231B to be paid by the owners of the real property adjacent to said portion of said street and computing any surplus or deficit that might arise by reason of credits for previous work done or additional work that might have been encountered, is hereby declared to

be the sum of \$3,997.40.

Section 3. That the proportionate share of said probable cost of said improvement of said street assessed upon each lot or part thereof adjacent to said part of said street to be improved as aforesaid and as determined by said Council in and by said Resolution No. 231B is hereby ascertained and declared to be the sum set and placed immediately after the separate descriptions of each of such lots or parts thereof as follows:
