### CRDINANCE NO. 2401

AN ORDINANCE TO DETERMINE THE PROBABLE COST OF CERTAIN IMPROVEMENTS WHICH THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALDANY HAS DETERMINED TO MAKE IN RESOLUTION NO.2368 ADOPTED BY SAID COUNCIL ON THE 26TH DAY OF MARCH, 1952, FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF NINETEENTH AVENUE FROM ELM TO WALNUT

IN THE CITY OF ALBANY, CRESON; TO ASCERTAIN, ASSESS, DETERMINE AND DECLARE THE PROFORTIONATE SHARE OF SUCH PROBABLE COST OF SUCH IMPROVEMENT OF SAID STREET TO BE SO IMPROVED, TO DIRECT THE RECORDER OF SAID CITY TO ENTER A STATEMENT OF SUCH ASSESSMENT IN THE BOCKET OF CITY LIENS AS PROVIDED BY THE CHARTER OF SAID CLTY.

WHEREAS on the 12th day of Narch, 1952, the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon duly adopted a resolution requiring the City Engineer of said City to make plans and specifications for the improvement of Nineteenth Avenue from Elm to Walnut

in the following manner, to-wit:

1. Grade and gravel
2. Asphalt concrete

3. Curb and gutter

Sidewalk

and for the estimates of the work to be done on said portion of said street and the probable cost thereof and requiring that such plans, specifications, and estimates and probable cost be filed in the Recorder's office of said City, said resolution being endorsed "Resolution No.238A" and adopted 12th day of March, 1952.

WHEREAS the City Engineer of said City of Albany pursuant to said

Resolution No. 238A made plans, specifications and estimates as directed by the said resolution for the improvement of said street in the manner specified in said Resolution No. 238A and filed said plans, specifications and estimates in the Recorder's office of said City on the 28th day of March, 1932.

WHEREAS the Council on the 26th day of March, 1952 by Resolution No. 236B duly adopted by said Council, determined and resolved that it deemed it expedient and that said Council, proposed to improve 19th Avenue from Elm to Walnut

in the manner provided in said Resolution No. 2388 , and

WHEREAS in and by said Resolution No.2388 adopted as aforesaid by the Council, the Recorder of said City was duly ordered and directed by said Council to give notice of said proposed improvement of said street

said Council to give notice of said proposed improvement of said screet in the manner provided in said Resolution No. 2388, and WHEREAS the Recorder in pursuance of said order and direction of the Council of said City did duly give notice of said proposed improvement of said street in the manner provided by the Charter of said City, and Whereas the Council in and by said Resolution No. 2388 ascertained

and ditermined the total probable cost of making said improvement of said street to be paid by the owners of the real property adjacent to said portion of said street to is improved as specified in Resolution No. 2368 to be the sum of \$3506.96.

#### THEREFORE

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO CRDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Nineteenth Avenue from Elm to Walnut

in the City of Albany, Orecon to improved as follows:

1. Grade and gravel
2. Asphalt concrete
4. Sidewall

3. Curb and gutter 4. Sidewalk

all in accordance with said Resolution No. 238Band the plans and specifications for said improvement filed by the City Engineer with the Recorder of said City of Albany, Gragon on the 26th day of March, 1952.

Section 2. That the probable cost of making said improvement of said street in the manner heretofore determined by the Council of Albany in and by Resolution No. 238B to be paid by the owners of the real proper-ty adjacent to said portion of said street and computing any surplus or deficit that might arise by reason of credits for previous work done or additional work that might have been encountered, is hereby declared to

be the sum of \$3,506.96.
Section 3. That the proportionate share of said probable cost of Section 3. That the proportionate share of said probable cost of said improvement of said street assessed upon each lot or part thereof adjacent to said part of said street to be improved as aforesaid and as determined by said Council in and by said Resolution No.2388 is hereby ascertained and declared to be the sum set and placed immediately after the separate descriptions of each of such lots or parts thereof as follows:
