AN ORDINANCE TO DETERMINE THE PROBABLE COST OF CERTAIN IMPROVEMENTS WHICH THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALBANY HAS DETERMINED TO MAKE IN RESOLUTION HO. ADOPTED BY SAID COUNCIL ON THE 26TH DAY OF MARCH, 1952, FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF QUEEN AVENUE FROM BROADWAY TO BLM 2398
