AN ORDINANCE TO DETERMINE THE PROBABLE COST OF CERTAIN IMPROVEMENTS WHICH THE COUNCI'. OF THE CITY OF ALBANY HAS DETERMINED TO MAKE IN RESOLUTION NO. 2428 ADOPTED BY SAID COUNCIL ON THE 26TH DAY OF MARCH, 1952, FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF FOURTEENTH AVENUE FROM LAWNRIDGE TO TAKENA

IN THE CIT! OF ALBANY, OREGON; TO ASCERTAIN, ASSESS, DETERMINE AND DECLARE THE PROPORTIONATE SHARE OF SUCH PRODABLE COST OF SUCH IMPROVEMENT OF SAID STREET TO E SO IMPROVED, TO DIRECT THE RECORDER OF SAID CITY TO ENTER A STATEMENT SHE SUCH ASSESSMENT IN THE DOCKET OF CITY LIENS AS PROVIDED BY T CHARTER OF SAID CITY.

WHERE is on the 12th day of March, 1952, the Council of the City of Albany, Or gon duly adopted a resolution requiring the City Engineer of said City o make plans and specifications for the improvement of Fourteenth Avenue from Lawnridge to Takena

and for the estimates of the work to be done on said portion of said street and the probable cost thereof and requiring that such plans, specifications and estimates and probable cost be filed in the Recorder's office of said City, said resolution being endorsed "Resolution No. 242A" and adopted

No. 2428 only adopted by said Council, determined and resolved that it
