

ORDINANCE NO. 2589

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE "DON DENSMOOR CHEVROLET COMPANY" FOR THE PURCHASE OF TWO POLICE CARS FROM THE DON DENSMOOR CHEVROLET COMPANY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Recorder did heretofore advertise for the bids for two police cars for the City of Albany, and

WHEREAS, said bids were received and duly opened at the time herein set forth, and

WHEREAS, upon recommendation of the Council of the City of Albany,

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:


That the Mayor and City Manager of the City of Albany are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with the Don Densmoor Chevrolet Company, of Albany, Oregon, for the purchase of two 1955 Chevrolet 4-door Sedan with V-8 motors at the bid price for the two units less trade-in allowance on two 1954 Ford 4-door Sedans making a balance upon the contract of \$1,272.00, and

By this ordinance does hereby ratify any action heretofore taken as herein provided.

Inasmuch as the passage of this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Albany, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and its approval by the Mayor of the City of Albany.
