

ORDINANCE NO. 2612

AN ORDINANCE RENAMING SEVENTEENTH AVENUE FROM LAFAYETTE STREET TO A POINT APPROXIMATELY ONE HALF BLOCK WEST OF THURSTON STREET IN EPAULINE ADDITION TO BE KNOWN AS SIXTEENTH PLACE.

R E C I T A L S :

1. The Planning and Zoning Commission has recommended the renaming of Seventeenth Avenue from Lafayette Street to a point approximately one half block west of Thurston Street in Epauline Addition.

2. The Council accepted the recommendation of the Planning and Zoning Commission and set October 26, 1955, as the day for public hearing, pursuant to 227.120 O.R.S.


THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS :

Section 1: The street heretofore named as Seventeenth Avenue as shown by the recorded plat of Epauline Addition is hereby renamed and will be known as "Sixteenth Place".

Section 2: The Recorder shall file a certified copy of this ordinance with the County Recorder, the County Assessor and the County Surveyor of Linn County.
