

ORDINANCE NO. 2628

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY MANAGER TO LEASE FOR A PERIOD OF THREE YEARS FROM DECEMBER 1, 1955, THE BARRETT BUILDING TO WALTER MARTIN AND ARTHUR MARTIN, dba, ALBANY NEON SIGN COMPANY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The Council has determined it impracticable to request bids on the leasing of the building situated on the following described property, to-wit:

Lot Four (4), Block Six (6), City of
Albany, Oregon, (commonly known as
the Barrett Building)

and has deemed the said building unnecessary for city government purposes for a period of three years beginning December 1, 1955.

Section 2: The Mayor and City Manager are hereby authorized and directed to lease the building above described for a period of three (3) years beginning December 1, 1955, to the present tenants, Walter Martin and Arthur Martin, dba Albany Neon Sign Company for a monthly rental of ONE HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$165.00). The terms of the lease are to be substantially those set forth in the previous lease.
