

ORDINANCE NO. 2668

AN ORDINANCE ELECTING TO DISPENSE WITH AN ELECTION WITHIN THE CITY OF ALBANY, PURSUANT TO 222.120 ORS, REGARDING THE ANNEXATION OF A PORTION OF GOLTRA PARK ADDITION; SETTING FORTH A TIME FOR A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE SAME AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, there has heretofore been filed with the City Recorder of the City of Albany a petition by persons representing themselves as owners or equitable owners of property in a portion of Goltra Park Addition to the City of Albany requesting the council of the City of Albany to dispense with an election within the City of Albany for annexation of a certain portion of Goltra Park Addition and requesting that a date be set for the hearing on the said proposal.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That an election within the City of Albany for the purpose of annexing the following described property to-wit:

Beginning at the intersecting point of the north line of Queen Avenue and the east line of Marion Street extended;
thence South to the southwest corner of Block 1, Goltra Park Addition;
thence East along the south line of Blocks 1 and 2 Goltra Park Addition to the southwest corner of Block 3, Goltra Park Addition;
thence south along the west line of Blocks 6 and 11, Goltra Park Addition to the south line of "D" Street;
thence west along the south line of "D" Street five feet;
thence southerly along the east line of Jackson Street (formerly Park Avenue) 683.0 feet;
thence easterly parallel to the south line of Block 3, Goltra Park Addition 457 feet; more or less to a point on the present city limits of Albany, Linn County, Oregon;
thence northerly and westerly following the present city limits of Albany, Oregon, to the place of beginning.

It shall be and it is hereby dispensed with pursuant to and under the terms of 222.120 O.R.S.


Section 2: There shall be held a public hearing as to the advisability of annexing that portion of Goltra Park Addition described in Section 1 to the City of Albany, on the 8th day of August, 1956, at the hour of 7:15 o'clock P.M. and the City Recorder of the City of Albany is hereby directed to give notice of the said public hearing by publishing in a newspaper of general circulation in the said city once a week for two (2) successive weeks prior to the hearing and by posting notice in four (4) public places for the same length of time, setting forth the time and place of the said hearing, and the description of the property to be considered for annexation and the purpose for which the hearing is held.

Section 3: Whereas, it is for the betterment of the public's health, safety and general welfare of the citizens of the City of Albany that the matter of the annexation of the property described herein be disposed of at the earliest possible moment and be considered at a special election to be held in the said territory, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall become immediately effective, upon its passage by the council and approval by the Mayor.
